A biodegradable product has the abilitity to break down, safely and relatively quickly by biological means, into the raw materials of nature and disappear into the environment.



Fairtrade changes the way trade works through better prices, decent working conditions and a fairer deal for farmers and workers in developing countries.


Cocoa Horizons

The Foundation's mission is to improve the livelihoods or cocoa farms and their communities through the promotion of sustainable, entrepreneurial farming, improving productivity and community development.

Cocoa Horizons implements impactful activities at scale that drive meaningful change in cocoa farming communities. These activities enable farmers to lift themselves out of poverty, eradicate child labour, and results in a deforestation-free cocoa supply chain.















Eco Baton Chocolate Bar

Healthy Snack Cup








Protein Bar
